- ~ Wrestlers **MUST** meet age and weight requirements for at least one of the YNEW competition groups
- ~ Wrestlers select their own weight class during registration; YNEW weight class can be different than state weight class
- ~ A **STRICT** one pound allowance (+1 lb) will be added to each weight class limit (**MAXIMUM WEIGHT** = Weight Class Limit + 1 lb Allowance)
- ~ All wrestlers **MUST** weigh **LESS THAN** their **MAXIMUM WEIGHT** during YNEW Weigh-ins in order to compete in the Youth New Englands
- ~ Wrestlers **MUST RESIDE** in one of the six New England (NE) states in order to be **ELIGIBLE** for the Youth New Englands
- ~ **PART-TIME RESIDENTS** of an NE state **MUST COMPETE** in their NE State Tournament in order to be **ELIGIBLE** for the Youth New Englands
- ~ Wrestlers who compete in their **High School Varsity POSTSEASON** are **NOT ELIGIBLE** for the Youth New Englands in the same year
- ~ ALL girl wrestlers who meet age, weight, and residency requirements are eligible for the Girls New Englands (exception: see HS Rule above)
- ~ Girl wrestlers may participate in both **GIRLS** and **OPEN** competition groups for which they are age-eligible
- ~ **ALL** state place finishers from the six New England states are **ELIGIBLE** to compete in the Youth New Englands
- ~ A limited number of **WILDCARD** slots are available for those who do not place in their state tournament
- ~ Madison and/or round robin bracketing may be used when a weight class is not full (less than six)
- ~ Age challenge available for \$50 fee; age misrepresentation results in forfeiture of individual placement and team points
- ~ It may not be feasible to resolve an age challenge on competition day; tournament records will reflect any revisions
